## MAKING NEWHAM SAFER

The Council, the Police and other agencies  
are working together in a Crime and Disorder  
Reduction Partnership to make Newham  
a safer place for everyone.

## Some of the successes so far include:

- \* The introduction of a Safer Neighbourhood Team for every ward in Newham (by April 2006)
- \* The closure of over 200 cannabis factories in 2005
- \* More police and PCSO (Police Community Support Officer) patrols in crime or disorder hotspots
- \* The successful prosecution of 66 offenders who sold alcohol, tobacco, or fireworks to underage children in the last year.
- \* Modern CCTV in more locations
- \* The use of new legislation to reduce youth disorder in Newham
- \* The setting up of a partnership unit to target persistent and prolific offenders
- \* The removal of 4,224 abandoned or untaxed vehicles from the streets in the last year
- \* A 41% reduction in the number of abandoned vehicles that are set alight since 2003
- \* A 56% reduction in the number of hoax calls to London Fire Brigade since 2003
