ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACE

Pursuant to the Criminal Justice and Police Act 2001 and the Local Authorities (Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places) Regulations 2007, the London Borough of Newham has on the 6th day of December 2010 made a Designated Public Places Order (DPPO)

1. The DPPO covers the whole of the area of the London Borough of Newham save Transport for London (TFL) premises listed below.. The pre-existing DPPO that applies in Stratford Town Centre and the Woodgrange Road area for Forest Gate is revoked on the coming into effect of the borough-wide DPPO.
2. The effect of the DPPO on the area is to make it an offence for any person to drink alcohol in the designated area after being required by a Police Officer or Police Community Support Officer not to do so. The police would also have the power to confiscate and dispose of any alcohol and containers in the person's possession. In either case a person may be arrested if they fail, without reasonable excuse, to comply with the officer's request to stop drinking alcohol or hand over any alcohol when asked to do so.

In relation to the categories of premises falling under the following regulations of the Local Authorities (Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places) Regulations 20007, the effect of the DPPO is set as set out against each regulation below.

Regulation 3(3)(b)(i) –Premises in respect of which a premises licence exists that authorises the sale or supply of alcohol – The DPPO will have no effect

Regulation 3(3)(b)(ii) – Premises in respect of which a premises licence exists that authorises the sale or supply of alcohol where the premises licence is held by the London Borough of Newham(LBN) or the premises licence is held by another but occupied by LBN or managed by LBN – The DPPO will have no effect at times when alcohol is being sold or supplied or within 30 minutes thereafter.

Regulation 3(3)(b)(iii) - Premises in respect of which a club premises certificate has effect which certifies that the premises may be used by the club for the sale or supply of alcohol – The DPPO will have no effect


Regulation 3(3)(b)(iv) - A place within the curtilage of premises in respect of which a licence to sell or supply alcohol or club premises certificate exists - The DPPO will have no effect

Regulation 3(3)(b)(v) - Premises which by virtue of Part 5 of the Licensing Act 2003 (permitted Temporary Activities) may be used for the supply of alcohol or which by virtue of that part could have been so used within the last 30minutes. – The DPPO will have no effect

Regulation 3(3)(b)(vi) – A place where facilities or activities relating to the sale or consumption of the alcohol are for the time being permitted by virtue of a permission granted under section 115E of the Highways Act 1980(c.66) (highway related uses). - The DPPO will have no effect

3. The DPPO will come into effect on the 17 January 2011
