



How to compost your green garden waste

Play your part for
a Cleaner, Greener
Newham.

There are three ways to dispose of your green garden waste in Newham.



1 We will collect items such as grass cuttings, leaves, weeds, flowers, twigs, and prunings within two working days of your collection being booked. Call us on 020 8430 2000 and then leave your green garden waste in a bag or tied in bundles in the front garden of your property. (Please do not use your orange bags).

2 You can also take your green garden waste to Jenkins Lane, Reuse and Recycling Centre free of charge. Garden waste such as hedge cuttings, leaves, grass cuttings, twigs will be composted locally and turned into a soil improver.

3 The most economical and environmentally sustainable method of dealing with green garden waste is composting it at home. We subsidise the cost of compost bins, to find out more please visit: www.newham.getcomposting.com or call 0845 130 6090

Uncooked fruit and vegetables, including cores and peelings, teabags, plant prunings, grass cuttings, cardboard such as egg boxes, scrunched up paper, fallen leaves, crushed eggshells, wood ash and shredded newspapers can be thrown into your compost bin to make great compost.
