

Public Space Protection Order 2015
Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014

Beckton, Custom House and Royal Docks Wards

1. The London Borough of Newham Council ("the Council") hereby makes this Public Spaces Protection Order, pursuant to section 59 of the Anti- Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("Act"). The Council has complied with the statutory requirements of section 72 of the Anti-social Behaviour Act 2014 and undertaken the necessary consultation.
2. This Order takes effect on 7th December 2015 and will remain in force for three years thereafter.
3. The effect of this Order is to restrict activities listed below in paragraph 4.1 – 4.5 in the public places described as Restricted Area A and Restricted Area B in the Schedule of this Order and shown hatched in blue and green on the map annexed to this Order ("the Restricted Areas").
 - 3.1. Restricted Area A covers all public spaces in the three wards of Beckton, Royal Docks and Custom House within the borough of Newham as shown outlined in blue on annexed map marked "Restricted Area A".
 - 3.2. Restricted Area B covers all public spaces within Beckton District Park North, Beckton District Park and New Beckton Park, as outlined in green on annexed map marked "Restricted Area B" .
4. The Council is satisfied that the activities listed in paragraph 4.1 – 4.5 have been carried out within the Restricted Areas and that they have a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality. The effect of the activities is of a persistent or continuing nature, and is such as to make the activities unreasonable and justifies the restrictions imposed by this order.

The activities carried out are as follows:

- 4.1. Large numbers of individuals have been gathering in motor vehicles and motorcycles in Restricted Area A on Friday and Saturday evenings causing noise, public nuisance and depositing litter.
- 4.2. Drivers have been using Restricted Area A to display and race motor vehicles and motorcycles on public roads and spaces and are a danger to other road users and pedestrians.
- 4.3. The motor vehicle gatherings have attracted vehicle borne retailers to unlawfully trade within Restricted Area A without the requisite lawful permissions, street trading licences or the permission of the landowners.

Restricted Area B :-

- 4.4. Individuals on motorcycles have been entering the public open spaces and riding dangerously and recklessly, causing damage to the park areas, noise nuisance and danger and distress to park users.

4.5. The activities have resulted in complaints from users of the public space of public nuisance, danger and distress.

5. This Order prohibits:

Restricted Area A :-

- 5.1. Entry to Restricted Area A by persons in motor vehicles and motorcycles between the hours of 8pm and 6am for the purpose of engaging in vehicle displaying and racing.
- 5.2. Gathering in a public place in Restricted Area A with others for the purpose of preparing for motor vehicles and motorcycle racing or preparing motor vehicles and motorcycles for displaying or racing.
- 5.3. Attending or gathering in a public place for the purpose of watching motor vehicle and motorcycles being displayed or raced.
- 5.4. Congregating and loitering in groups and engaging in behaviour which is likely to cause harassment, alarm or distress between the hours of 8pm and 6am.
- 5.5. Selling, offering or exposing for sale any goods, food or any other item within the public open spaces within Restricted Area A without prior written permission of the land owner, planning permission, or a street trading licence or other lawful permission.

Restricted Area B:-

- 5.6. Entry to Restricted Area B (Beckton District Park and New Beckton Park) by persons in any motor vehicle or motorcycle except for service vehicles for the purposes of maintenance and repair of the open spaces, or mobility vehicles being used by disabled persons or disabled blue badge holders.

6. This Order imposes the following positive requirements:

Persons selling, offering or exposing to sell goods within Restricted Area A shall produce upon demand written permission from the land owner or a street trading licence to trade within Restricted Area A to a Police Constable, a Police Community Support Officer, or an Authorised Council Officer.

7. Criminal Offence:

- 7.1. Failure without reasonable excuse to comply with the prohibitions or requirements imposed in this proposed Order is a summary offence under section 67 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 Act. A person guilty of an offence is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.
- 7.2. A Police Constable, a Police Community Support Officer, or an Authorised Council Officer may, under section 68 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014, issue a Fixed Penalty Notice to any person he or she has reason to believe has committed an offence (£1,000).

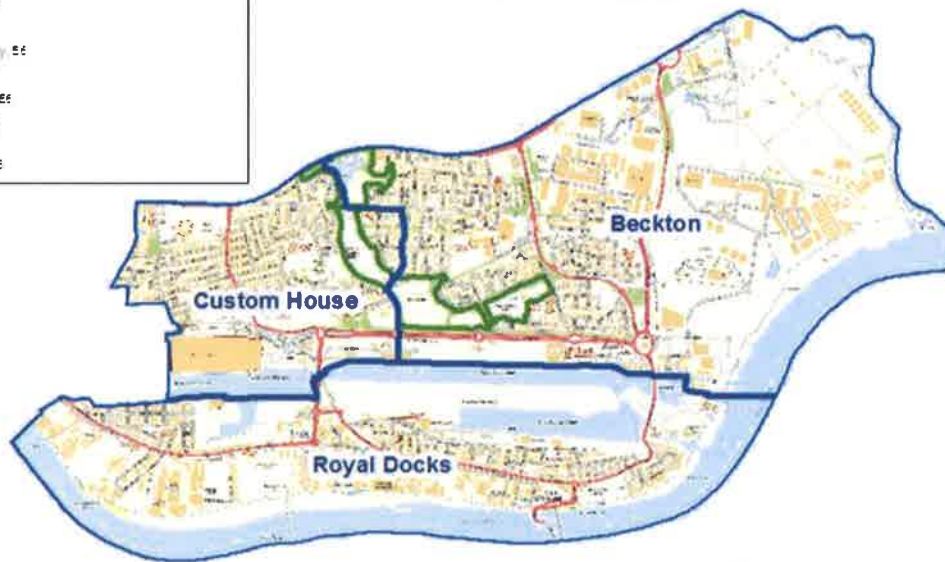
