The Charging Authority is the London Borough of Newham.

This summary relates to the calendar year 2026¹, and applies to all CIL liable development across the borough.

The London Borough of Newham's CIL charging schedule came into effect on 1 January 2014.

In order to respond to market conditions, the CIL is subject to annual indexation to reflect inflation. A specific index, which charging authorities must use, has been created for this purpose. More information is available on the RICS website.

Table A below sets out details of the original CIL Charging Schedule rates from 2014 and the rate that will be charged for CIL liable developments granted planning permission in 2026. The CIL Charging Zones map is included on page 3 of this document.

Where: **R** is the relevant CIL rate from the adopted charging schedule.

Iy is the index figure for the given calendar year.

Ic is the index figure for the calendar year in which the charging

schedule took effect.

2026 Index figure published by RICS:

ly = **400** for the given calendar year 2026

Ic = 239 the index figure for 2014 (when the charging schedule took effect)

Interpretation of chargeable amount and Use Classes Order

The collecting authority applies the relevant legislation in effect for each chargeable development.

The Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2020 (as amended) introduced Use Classes not identified within the charging authority's 2014 Charging Schedule and therefore the equivalent rates will be applied².


The transfer of powers from the London Legacy Development Corporation (LLDC)
