

## Adoption Statement Local Plan

In accordance with Regulation 26 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Newham formally adopted the Local Plan 2018, at Full Council on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2018. In doing so the Local Plan: Core Strategy (2012) and the Local Plan: Detailed Sites and Policies Development Plan Document (2016) were formally superseded and withdrawn.

The Local Plan was the subject of an Independent Examination conducted by an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State. The Inspector's Report was published in November 2018 and the recommended Main Modifications and associated Minor Modifications have been included in the adopted document which now carries full weight in the consideration of planning applications. The Inspector's Report containing a Schedule of Main Modifications can also be viewed on the Council's website.

Any person who is aggrieved by the adoption of the Local Plan may make an application to the High Court under section 113 of the Planning & Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, on the grounds that the document is not within the appropriate powers conferred by Part 2 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and/or a procedural requirement of the Act or its associated Regulations has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made promptly, and no later than the end of the six week challenge period, starting with the date on which the Plan was adopted (10<sup>th</sup> December 2018).
