Newham Data is our flagship programme driving our Local Growth Plan. We are using data, digital and artificial intelligence to improve public services, grow Newham's local economy and equip our residents with skills required for the world of work.

Newham Data Overview

Launched by Mayor Rokhsana Fiaz OBE in 2021, our Newham Data programme is positioning Newham as one of the most exciting places in the capital for London's growing data and AI economy. We are providing meaningful skills training and job opportunities for Newham's residents and supporting local businesses in using data and AI to improve customer insight and business planning to boost productivity.

Since its launch, Newham Data has:

- **Built a nationally recognised public-sector AI capability**, including the UK Centre for AI in the Public Sector, launched with the University of East London in 2024 and shortlisted for national awards in 2025. Its flagship project reduces pressure on temporary accommodation services, getting people into accommodation faster.
- **Created practical skills pathways** into data and digital jobs for young people, adults and small businesses through programmes including Newham Data Youth Ambassadors, the AWS Cloud Computing Bootcamp and employer-led AI skills workshops.
- **Worked with schools and education partners to strengthen data and AI learning**, supporting curriculum enrichment, employer engagement and early exposure to data careers for secondary-age students.
- **Secured over £1.2 billion of inward digital investment into Newham**, securing two hyperscale data centres (210MW Royal Docks and 80MW Canning Town), strengthening Newham's role at the heart of London's data and AI economy.
- **Activated global and local partnerships** with Cognizant, Microsoft, AWS, the Open Data Institute, Girls in Data, Bloomberg Associates, SXSW and others to create pipelines for talent, mentoring, curriculum innovation and employer-led learning.

Pathways into Data/AI Careers

Data Ambassadors 5-week training for 16–18 year olds in Newham schools, combining data and AI skills, career insight and mock interviews, delivered by Microsoft, Cognizant and other partners.

AI Skills Practical AI training for Newham residents and businesses delivered with Cognizant, Barclays and industry volunteers.

AI for Better Public Services

UK Centre for AI in the Public Sector Our partnership with the University of East London developing practical, ethical and scalable AI solutions to public sector challenges. The Centre's flagship project reduces workloads for temporary accommodation teams and helps match residents to suitable housing more quickly.
