We support Friends of Queen's Market in saying that there is no justified reason for this tall building zone, and it should be removed.

Tall buildings will harm the market. If developers wanted to try to build tall buildings they could now justify this by using the proposed policy D4 part 5. We ask the Council to delete D4 part 5 from proposed Local Plan.
