### Thank you for recycling, let's recycle even more!

Newham's Waste and Recycling team will be delivering a service trial in your area to help you recycle more of your waste.

As part of this service trial, you can add additional items such as glass bottles and jars, plastic tubs, pots, trays, aerosols and foil to your recyclable waste collection and, your recycling will be collected weekly.

This is a temporary service change that will take place from week commencing 14 September for a period of three months. We will notify you ahead of your recycling collections returning to normal services.

#### Your recycling collection day will not change.

Please put out your recyclable waste for collection **every week** on your usual collection day.



Some people will have access to their recycling bins restricted and will be given recycling bags. This helps us identify non-recyclable items more easily. If your recycling bin has been taped shut please use the orange recycling bags provided.

You can help by ensuring that you only put clean and dry recyclable items into your recycling. Please put items in loose (no black or plastic bags) no broken glass.

If you live in shared housing, **your** recycling is a **shared responsibility**. Please share this information with other people in your household.

In Newham, we collect paper, cardboard, plastic bottles, tins and cans for recycling.



During the trial, you can also add glass bottles and jars, plastic tubs, pots and trays, aerosols and foil to your recyclable waste collection.
