TESTING FOR SYMPTOMATIC STAFF

Arranged by Management: .gov.uk Care Home Testing Portal (CQC registered settings only) The .gov.uk care home testing portal allows employers to refer essential workers for testing if they are self-isolating because either they or member(s) of their household have symptoms.

Arranged by Management: NEL Regional Testing Portal

The NEL Regional Testing Portal enables staff in care settings to receive priority access to national drive-through testing sites or request a NEL home self-swabbing test kit via courier.

Arranged Themselves: .gov.uk Testing Portal

The .gov.uk testing portal includes an option for symptomatic essential workers, or symptomatic household members of essential workers.

There are four testing options available in Newham:

- **Regional drive-through test site** (*Nearest: Lea Valley Athletics Track / O2 Arena*)
- "Pop-Up" drive-through test site (Locations listed on national website)
- Home self-swabbing test kit
- Walk through test sites (Locations in East Ham & Beckton)
