

Vaccination: First doses given upto 10th March

- 68,882 1st dose given (18% of population). Of these :
- Cohort 1: 239 to older residents in care (92%)
- Cohort 2: 5,033 to 80+ (91.5%)
- Cohort 3: 8,293 to 75+ years (77%)
- Cohort 4: 13,739 to 70+ (77%), 19,905 to CEV (60%)
- 34,776 to under 70 years, including adults with risk conditions & frontline health and social care workforce

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

The number of new Covid-19 cases in Newham has fallen by 14% to 178. Positivity has also fallen to 1.5% while testing of school pupils has increased the overall testing rate. 68,882 first dose vaccines have been given – an increase by over 10,000 since last week. However, community transmission continues and the new strain of Covid-19 is highly transmissible which is why we need to keep following the advice and guidelines to ensure that the rates are as low as possible. This is the best way to protect our community and get back to a more normal life.

- Please ensure your face is covered when going to shops or other indoor places.
- Ensure you isolate if you have symptoms, test positive or are a contact. Support is available.
- Test yourself regularly if you leave the house for work or caring.
- If you have been invited for a vaccination please take it up.
