3. British Swimming Selection Trials @ London Aquatics Centre (14 <sup>th</sup> – 19 <sup>th</sup> April)	
Event is being held for GB swimmers and UK based athletes only with no international contestants. They anticipate a total of 365 in attendance including volunteers, staff and officials.	
Organisers shared their Covid testing protocols. Athletes, staff, volunteers and all officials will receive full Covid awareness briefing and will be required to sign a compliance code of conduct. Accreditation will be withdrawn immediately for non-compliance. Face coverings to be worn at all times in the hotel, travelling to and from the pool and inside the pool venue unless warming up and competing. Social distancing of at least 2 metres will be in place, temperature checks daily, verbal symptom checks and enhanced personal hygiene will be re-enforced.

Three event hotels will be used in Stratford to accommodate participants and officials, as well as facilitate testing and isolation for the required period. Strictly no socialising at the event or hotel.

Public Health Newham offered to facilitate a test site for volunteers on the park should it be required.

Walking routes and medical plan reviewed with partners. TFL advised organisers that there will be a one way system in place at the station with staff on hand to assist.
