Byelaws made under section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 by the London Borough of Newham for good rule and government and for the prevention and suppression of nuisances.

Application

1. These byelaws apply throughout the Borough of Newham.

Touting

- 2. No person shall
 - (a) advertise or solicit custom for any service; or
 - (b) seek to gather information for use in the supply of goods or services,

in such a manner as to cause obstruction or give reasonable grounds for annoyance to any person in the park.

Urination etc

3. No person shall urinate or defecate in any public place.

Penalty

4. Any person offending against these Byelaws shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.
