I undertake to maintain the compound or container or pit lane in a safe and satisfactory condition and to comply with any conditions attached to the licence.

The fees for a compound/ container/ pit lanes or flying compounds are as follows:-

- 1-3 Months £483.00 per month (3months = £1449.00)
- 4-6 Months £1449.00 + £ 963.00 per extra month (6months = £4338.00)
- 7-9 Months £4338.00 + £1627.00 per extra month (9months = £9219.00)
- 10-12 Months £9219.00 + £2101.00 per extra month (12months=£15,522.00)

A licence can be issued for a maximum of twelve months and will be renewable immediately after expiry unless the compound or container has been removed. Upon receipt of this application you will be advised of the total fees payable. Please allow a minimum of 15 working days to process applications.

Payment can be made over the phone via credit/debit card (please call the number below) Alternatively payment can be made by BAC's payment (please contact trafficorderapplications@newham.gov.uk for details. If you wish to submit this application in person at the office (address below) please ask for Saima at the reception. Please note that we do not charge V.A.T. on Container Licences or pit lanes and we do not issue V.A.T. receipts.


Upon receipt a preliminary inspection of the site will be undertaken and if approved a licence will be issued allowing the placing of the compound or container subject to a number of conditions, which will form part of the licence itself, and which will vary from site to site. Failure to adhere to these conditions will result in withdrawal of the licence.

Placing of the compound or container may not commence prior to the receipt of this licence.
