## Low Traffic Neighbourhood Area 4: Atherton is here

As part of the Low Traffic Neighbourhood (LTN) Area 4: Atherton, we have created two new access restrictions at the northern end of Carnarvon Road and at the eastern end of Earlham Grove to stop motorised vehicles from using your area as a cut through. As result, this will create more space for walking, cycling, scooting and to enjoy your streets. It will also improve road safety, in particular for people who need more time or focused attention using the road. This includes children and elderly people crossing the road, wheelchair users or those using other mobility aids, and families cycling.

The LTN scheme has been introduced on an experimental basis for up to 18 months.

During the first 6 months we will be collecting feedback from the local community to help us decide whether the scheme will be made permanent, or not, in the future.

This feedback will also help us understand your experience of the scheme, address any issues and to make any improvements.

It can take some time for people to get used to the changes and to adjust their journeys or the way they travel. However, as the scheme becomes more embedded and we continue to make improvements we hope that you will see the full benefits of removing through traffic from the area.
