2. UK Black Pride 14 August 22 debrief

Event was a huge success with 25k people attending on the day which was noted as the largest Black Pride globally.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Crowd flow through the park worked well, no noise complaints received • No refusals or ejections noted • Monkey Pox vaccination offer onsite which was received favourably <p>Learnings shared and discussed as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Earlier engagement with local security, transport and Westfield partners • Westfield to offer support with wayfinding going forward • Waste and litter management to be reviewed • More robust stewarding on ingress and egress routes • Hot weather was a challenge and weather mitigations to be re-assessed <p>Chair added that the event was well received and had positive feedback. LLDC and organisers to discuss the potential of returning in 2023.</p>	
<p>3. Great Get Together & Live site debrief</p> <p><u>Great Get Together</u> GGT new format and location worked extremely well. Organisers saw a total of approximately 25k attending throughout the course of the day with peak times reaching a maximum of 10k. Ingress and egress ran smoothly.</p> <p>Discussions continued reviewing learnings on the day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • End time to be reviewed as site cleared by 6.30pm/7pm • A wider range of vegan/vegetarian options to be included next year • Funfair location to be re-assessed along with the road closure which caused minor issues on the day • Usage of sites to be discussed and reviewed going forward with learnings implemented <p><u>Live Site – 10th Anniversary</u> There were sixteen days of programming which all ran smoothly with minor internal supply issues.</p> <p>Marketing Campaign by CWG22 was delayed which may have impacted attendance and event was therefore over staffed. Positive feedback was received from those that attended.</p> <p>LVRPA thanked partners for accommodating all the last minute requests from CWG22.</p>	
<p>4. QEOP Half Marathon 27 November 22</p> <p>Event overview and route shared with members. 3k participants expected to take part, the half marathon starts at 9am and the 10k at 9.25am.</p> <p>Road closures due in place from 8am till 2pm and reopening on a rolling basis. Roads to remain sterile on the course. There is ongoing consultation with partners as the 9am start clashes with Black Friday weekend.</p> <p>Event village will be situated on the Stadium Island with the concourse and Bridge 2 in use. LS185 are reviewing the EMP and discussions and comments will be continued offline with organisers. LBN Noise team were satisfied with the stage set up and timings.</p>
