Who we are and what this booklet is about



We are **Newham Council**. We want Beckton to be a great place for people to walk and cycle.



We have a plan to make it easier and safer for people to walk and cycle in Beckton, but we want your help.



We want to know what changes you would like us to make. We have written some questions for you to answer and to tell us what you think. This is called a survey.



This booklet tells you about the changes we want to make and where you can find our survey.

Where we will make changes



We have chosen 4 places in Beckton that we want to change so they are better for people to walk and cycle. We call these our 4 key areas.

1. Beckton Town Centre

A busy place where people shop and travel from Beckton bus and train station. We want to make it easier for people to get to Asda.



2. Tollgate Road

A road that goes across Beckton and helps people get to houses, shops and the **community**.



Community means where you live and the people you know.





A main road in the South of Beckton that joins the A13 motorway.

4. Beckton Corridor

A footpath away from lots of cars that people can walk down. It is easy for people to walk from Beckton station to Beckton Park and Royal Albert Way.

We want to look at the changes we could make to Beckton's parks.



We will give everyone who lives in Beckton a chance to meet and share their ideas about how we can make Beckton's parks better.

Changes we could make





We have some ideas to make Beckton an easier and safer place or people to walk and cycle.

We could

- \checkmark make lanes just for bikes.
- \checkmark plant more trees and plants.
- ✓ buy better lights and CCTV cameras for outside.
- \checkmark change road junctions.
- ✓ make sure less cars drive in Beckton.
- ✓ make sure paths can be used by people who are disabled.
- make footpaths better for people to walk on.
- ✓ have more crossings like zebra crossings.
- ✓ put up more signs so people know where to walk or cycle.



We think more people would spend money in the local shops if we made these changes.



If we plant more trees and plants and make sure less cars drive in Beckton, the air will be cleaner and better for people to breathe in.

Changes we have already made





The 2 photos above show the changes we have already made to **Mitchell Walk** in Beckton.

We have taken away the steps so disabled people can use the path, put in new lights for when its dark, and CCTV so it is safer.

A team of people will plan what the changes to our 4 key areas and Beckton's parks will look like.

We will meet with people who live and work in Beckton to ask them what they think.



January

We will meet online with people who live and work in Beckton to ask them what they think.

We will meet with disabled people who live in Beckton to ask what makes it hard for them to walk, cycle, or wheel around Beckton.

March

We will start work on the changes we decide to make to our 4 key areas and Beckton's parks.
