





H&WB Support Roles Responses: Working with residents 67% of respond



67% of respondents use specific strategies for contacting hard to reach resident cohorts you work with?










- No need for social services, feel like they are wasting time and are of no importance.












Q34 How strongly do you agree or disagree with the following statement?


