Course price: FREE

What it is: 6 month fashion course, learn skills to assist you to enter the fashion industry. You will be required to attend 3 days a week, Tues, Weds and Thurs, 10am - 3pm and the age criteria is 16 - 25 year olds (+)

No previous skills required. There is no set term start date, you will be able to start the week after applying.

We have 10 spaces available

Previous participants have gone into jobs via introductions from Caramel rock to companies they have relationships with like ASOS, Nike etc
