WE ARE NEWHAM.

Condensation occurs when moisture collects as droplets on a cold surface when humid air is present. Dampness is caused by excessive condensation can lead to mould growth on walls, furniture and other fabrics.

How can damp, mould and condensation affect health?

Mould produces allergens, irritants and sometimes toxic substances affecting the immune system. This increases the risk of respiratory illnesses including Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disorder or asthma.

Inhaling or touching mould spores can result in allergic reactions such as sneezing, skin rash and lead to asthma attacks.

Free advice for landlords

If damp occurs due to an underlying repair issue, it is the landlord's responsibility to arrange for repairs to be completed within a reasonable time frame.
