A licence can be issued for up to 3 days per single site and is not for multiple locations. Upon receipt of this application you will be advised of the total fees payable.

Payment can only now be made either via a telephone credit card payment or by a BACs payment (details will sent via the pro-forma invoice).

If you require a full invoice please mention this on request as we normally only issue a Pro-forma invoice as we do not charge VAT on our licences.

Upon receipt a preliminary inspection of the site will be undertaken and if approved a licence will be issued allowing the use of mobile apparatus subject to a number of conditions, which will form part of the licence itself, and which will vary from site to site. Failure to adhere to these conditions will result in withdrawal of the licence.

Placing of the mobile apparatus may not commence prior to the receipt of the licence. Please allow 15 working days to process this application.
