

Trade Union Facility Time Publication

Publication Date: 31st July 2023

Relevant Period: 1st April 2022 – 31st March 2023

The Trade Union (Facility Time Publication Requirements) Regulations 2017 came into force on 1st April 2017 which requires public sector employers to publish specified information relating to facility time provided to trade union officials. Under the regulations, the relevant information will need to be published on an annual basis for the (relevant) period 1st April to 31st March. The information below is the information that is required to be published for the London Borough of Newham for the period 1st April 2022 to 31st March 2023.
