

Newham 20mph Programme

Delivering 20mph streets across Newham

Newham Council is planning to introduce a 20mph speed limit on most streets across the borough. Many streets are already 20mph and we want to reduce the speed limit on others so that our streets are safer for everyone to use.

Lower speed limits can help:



Reduce the number of collisions



Reduce the likelihood of serious injuries in collisions, especially for pedestrians



Reduce noise and pollution from motor traffic



Encourage people to walk and cycle more, if they can

The programme is planned to be delivered in phases, with the completion of the entire programme anticipated in 2025.

Some major roads are not included in the 20mph programme and will retain their existing speed limits. Private streets (e.g. in developments or estates) and streets that are not managed by the Council are also excluded from the Newham 20mph programme. All other streets are proposed to eventually become 20mph.

Phase 1

Phase 1 consists of streets in the northern section of the borough down to High Street and Romford Road (A118). We aim to implement 20mph streets in Phase 1 by spring 2024.
