The fees and charges for hoardings, have been set by the Council. The charges are variable dependent on the length, width and duration that the structure will be on the highway.

Pre Site inspection.

Any licence issued will be subject to a Pre-site inspection with the relevant LB Newham Network Operations Officer. This inspection will be subject to a fee of £114.00 per hour/per officer payable in advance of the inspection.

When the pre site inspection is undertaken, a licence will be issued, allowing the construction of the hoarding subject to any conditions agreed at the inspection, which will form part of the licence itself, and which will vary from site to site. Failure to adhere to these conditions will result in withdrawal of the licence.

Construction of the hoarding may not commence prior to the receipt of this licence. Applicants are advised that it is an offence to erect a hoarding without a licence under Section 169(5) Highways Act 1980.

Bond

A bond payment will also be required for all applications, this is refundable on completion of works provided no damage to the highway is caused. Part refunds, may be made subject to repair of the area damaged.

Licence length.

All licences are issued for a minimum of one month, to a maximum of twelve months and will need to be renewed prior to expiry unless we are notified in writing that the hoarding has been removed.

Payments

Payment can be made over the telephone via credit/debit card, alternatively payment can be made by BACS Payment (all details will be provided once quotation forwarded to you). Please note that we do not charge V.A.T. on hoarding licences and we do not issue V.A.T. receipts.
