


Chobham Manor Phase 2 Junction Improvements

Honour Lea Avenue / Olympic Park Avenue junction

Proposal

- Convert zebra crossing to a parallel crossing and better align with direction of travel
- Extend segregated cycle lane on Honour Lea Avenue and Olympic Park Avenue
- Enlarge pavement at corners with new dropped kerbs
- Better align dropped kerbs with direction of travel

Reasons

- Provide safe crossing that better aligns with direction of travel for pedestrians and cyclists

- Provide additional segregation between pedestrians and cyclists
- Provide safe crossing for cyclists
- Reduce vehicle speed when turning corners

Funding

- LLDC Community Infrastructure Levy Grant (CIL)

Construction

- Autumn 2024 – Winter 2025 (specific dates TBC)

Road ownership

- London Borough of Newham

Abercrombie Road / Temple Mills Lane junction

Proposal

- Continuous footway and cycle lane across the junction
- A modal filter restricting all motor vehicles except emergency vehicles and buses and coaches for the Velodrome from entering Abercrombie Road from Temple Mill Lane yet allowing all vehicles to exit out of Abercrombie Road.

Reasons

- Continuous foot and cycle way will prioritise pedestrians and cyclists to encourage more people to choose to walk and cycle
- The modal filter will reduce Abercrombie Road being used as a 'rat run' to avoid lights at junction of Temple Mill Lane and Honour Lea Avenue
- The modal filter will make it safer and easier for pedestrians and cyclists to cross as traffic is coming from one direction only.

Road ownership

- London Borough of Newham

Abercrombie Road and Olympic Avenue (street)

Proposal

- Traffic calming
- 4no. speed cushions on Abercrombie Road and 2no. speed cushions on Olympic Park Avenue.

Reasons

- Reduce vehicle speeds

Funding

- LLDC Community Infrastructure Levy Grant (CIL)

Construction

- Autumn 2024 – Winter 2025 (specific dates TBC)

Road ownership

- London Borough of Newham

Other projects in the Chobham Manor area

1. Chobham Manor (completed)

- 20mph speed limit on all roads in Chobham Manor completed in Spring 2024

2. Honour Lea Ave (completed)

- Improvements to four junctions completed in 2023

3. Honour Lea Avenue (future project)

- Traffic Management Order (TMO) for new waiting and loading restrictions and new loading bay locations - statutory consultation will take place Autumn 2024. Residents will be receiving letters.
