# Annual CIL rate summary 2025 The London Borough of Newham

The Charging Authority is the London Borough of Newham.

The year to which this annual CIL rate summary relates is the calendar year 2025<sup>1</sup>, and is applicable to CIL liable development across the borough.

The London Borough of Newham's CIL charging schedule first came into effect on 1 January 2014.

In order to respond to market conditions, the CIL is subject to an index of inflation. A specific index has been created which must be used by charging authorities. More information on this is available on the RICS website.

Table A below sets out details of the original CIL charging schedule rates from 2014 and the rate that will be charged for CIL liable developments granted planning permission in 2025. The CIL Charging Zones map is included on page 3 of this document.

Ic is the index figure for the calendar year in which the Charqing

Schedule took effect.

2025 Index figure published by RICS:

Ic = 239 the index figure for 2014 (when the charging schedule took effect)

#### Interpretation of chargeable amount and Use Classes Order

The collecting authority refers to and implements the relevant legislation in effect associated with each chargeable development.

The Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) (Amendment) (England) Regulations 2020 (as amended) introduced Use Classes not identified within the charging authority's 2014 Charging Schedule and therefore the equivalent rates will be applied<sup>2</sup>.


#### The transfer of powers from the London Legacy Development Corporation (LLDC)

The London Legacy Development Corporation (LLDC) officially dissolved on 30 November 2024. Before this dissolution, the LLDC transferred its powers to the London Borough of Newham (LBN), effective 1 December 2024. From that date onward, LBN have assumed the role and taken on the responsibilities of the charging and collecting authority for the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) schedules that were established by LLDC within Newham boundaries.
