Stage: Newham Submission Draft Local Plan (Reg. 19)

1. Introduction

- 1.1. This Statement of Common ground addresses key matters/issues between the two signatories, the London Borough of Newham and London City Airport, as relevant to:
 - the preparation of the Newham Draft Submission Local Plan and its progression to public examination.
- 1.2. London City Airport made a number of comments and suggested modifications to a number of policies in the draft Submission Local Plan, this Statement of Common Ground relates to policies GWS1, T5, D4, N1, N2, N3, N4, N5 and N17.
- 1.3. This Statement of Common Ground sets out the areas of agreement between the London Borough of Newham and London City Airport, and outlines resulting minor modifications and/or proposes additional modifications to the Submission Local Plan, which will be provided to the Inspector for their consideration during the examination. These modifications have been agreed to by both parties.
- 1.4. In addition, Appendix 1 sets out a Statement of Fact on matters not agreed between London Borough of Newham and London City Airport.

2. Background

- 2.1. London City Airport is located in the heart of the Royal Docks. It is London's most central airport, just six miles to the City of London, two miles to Canary Wharf and half a mile from the ExCeL Exhibition and Conference Centre.
- 2.2. The Airport site extends over 60 hectares and includes operational infrastructure such as the runway, parallel taxiways, the main passenger terminal, a corporate aviation terminal (known as the Jet Centre), fuel farm and a digital control tower. Other passenger and supporting infrastructure include the staff office building (City Aviation House), surface parking, engineering and storage facilities.
- 2.3. The passenger terminal is served by a forecourt for drop-off and pick-up as well as a dedicated station on the Docklands Light Railway. The terminal is also served by three bus routes; the 473, 474 and 129.
- 2.4. Since opening in 1987, the Airport has grown to be one of the Borough's largest employers. At its peak in 2019 (prior to the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic), 5.1 million passengers passed through the Airport. Passenger numbers continue to recover since the pandemic. In 2024, 3.4 million passengers used the airport representing around 70% of the pre-pandemic levels.
- 2.5. The Airport has planning permission (13/01228/FUL) to extend is terminal building and infrastructure under the City Airport Development Programme (CADP1) A recent variation to this consent (22/03045/VAR) has allowed passenger growth to 9 million passengers per annum, as well as to increase the number of flights during the morning The section 73 permission has not yet been implemented by London City Airport.
