# Marshgate Lane Greenway Links Project

This joint project between LLDC and LBN involves comprehensive modernisation plans for the Greenway Marshgate Lane link to enhance transport infrastructure and connectivity in the area. A detailed presentation, including timelines and drawings of the proposed works shared and discussed with members. Presentation also circulated via email.

There are bi-monthly meetings with LLDC, Stadium, Network Rail, Bobby Moore Academy and ABBA Arena. UCL to be linked into these meetings

#### **Chobham Manor**

Improvement works from Celebration Avenue to Chobham Avenue will be delivered in phases. Phase 2 will cover Abercrombie/Temple Mill Lane, where a Copenhagen crossing will be introduced.

Resident engagement will take place ahead of the statutory consultation scheduled for autumn. SS (LVRP) has requested access to the resident's consultation prior to implementation.
